Resident Emma Palmatier – 387 Hill St.

- E. Palmatier has been the lead for the supportive housing project on behalf of LBN.
- She strongly supports the project because of the number of homeless people she sees in the community.
- The facility will be open to all who are homeless or near homelessness.
- She supports the rezoning application.

Resident Jean Sam - #1 Isaac Sam Drive

- Because of her years of working with those with mental health issues, she hopes this facility will provide accommodation for those with mental health issues.
- She also supports a short-term lodging option.
- She supports the proposed location.
