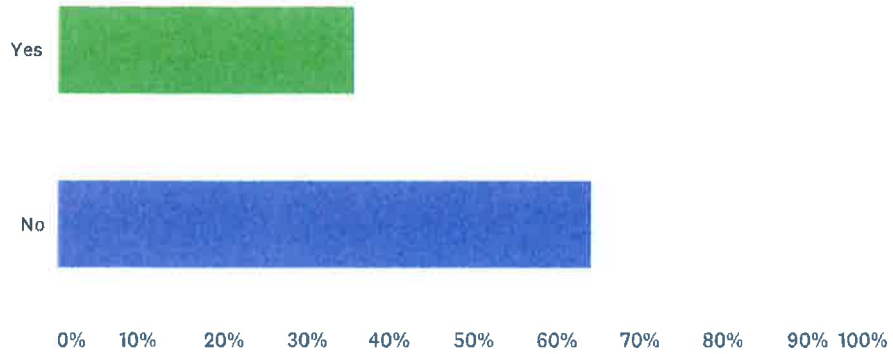


Q1 With the Heritage designation the exterior look of the building must remain the same no matter who owns it. Are you opposed to selling the building to a private enterprise?
