THE POSITION

Reporting to the Chief Administrative Officer, the Director of Recreation will provide leadership and support in the development, planning and administration of community recreation services and facilities for the Village of Burns Lake.

The Director of Recreation Services is responsible for the development and management of operations and programming in various local recreation facilities: Lakeside Multiplex, the Tom Forsyth Memorial Arena, the Burns Lake Curling Rink, and Burns Lake Spirit Square.

This position requires an emphasis on leadership, customer service and establishing positive relationships between the Village of Burns Lake and other local agencies to develop mutually acceptable solutions to complex situations. This position will require innovation, strong problem solving skills and the ability to work independently. We require a self-motivated individual passionate about building community and improving the quality of life for all residents; a community visionary to uncover opportunities for improved facilities and community service.
